With an IOSix ELD

First you need to create an admin account and then give the access to the driver by creating a separate account for the driver's ELD application.

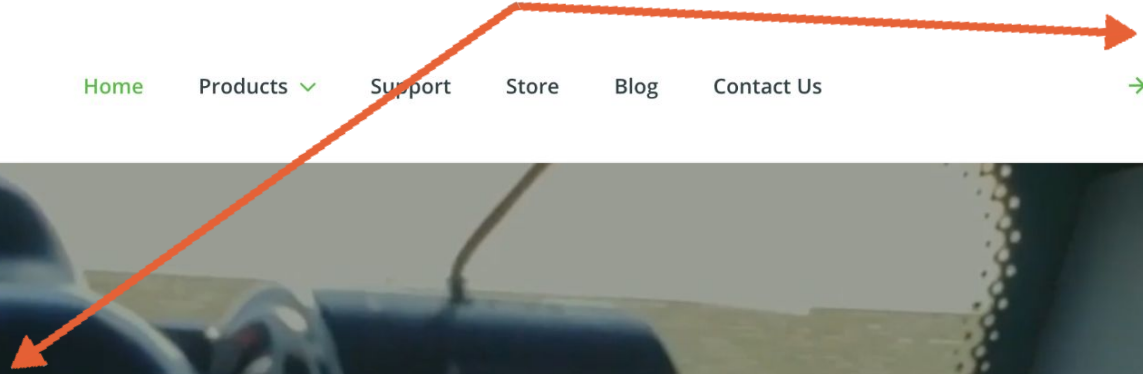
Set up your Admin Account

Step 1: Click Either of These Buttons to Begin

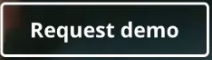




Step 2: Enter Your Name and Email Address



Step 6: Click ELD to show options, then click ELDs and after that ADD ELD



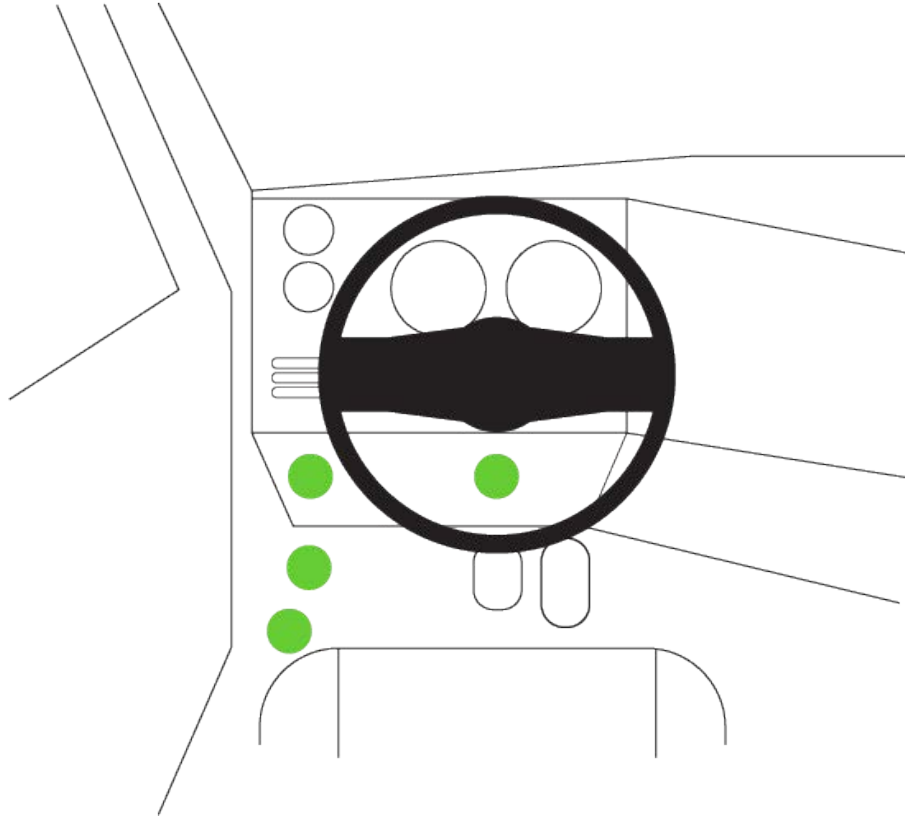


Install your ELD

To meet the requirements of the ELD rule, the GPSTab application must be launched and the ELD device must be connected prior to starting the engine.



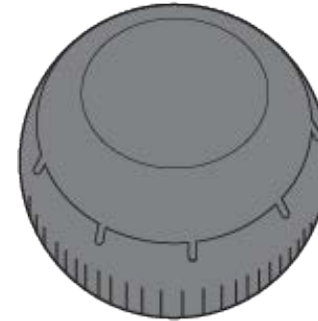
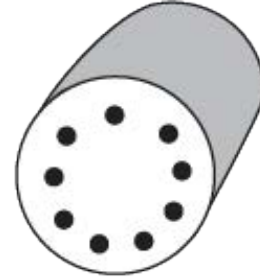
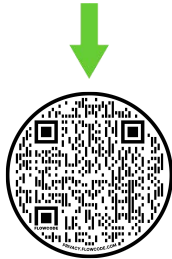
Step 19: Connect The Cable To The Port + The ELD

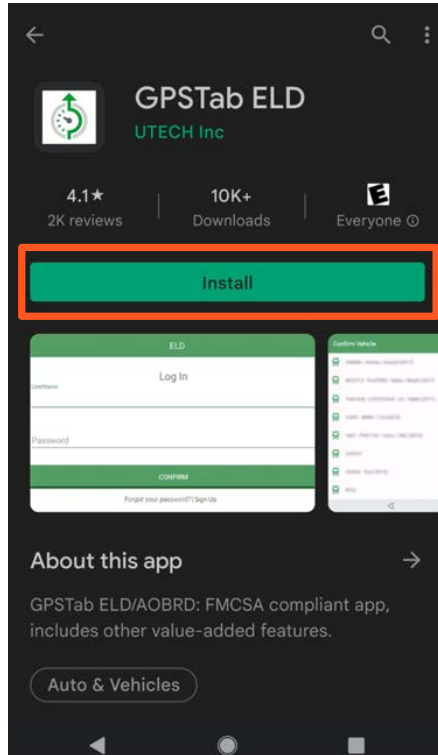

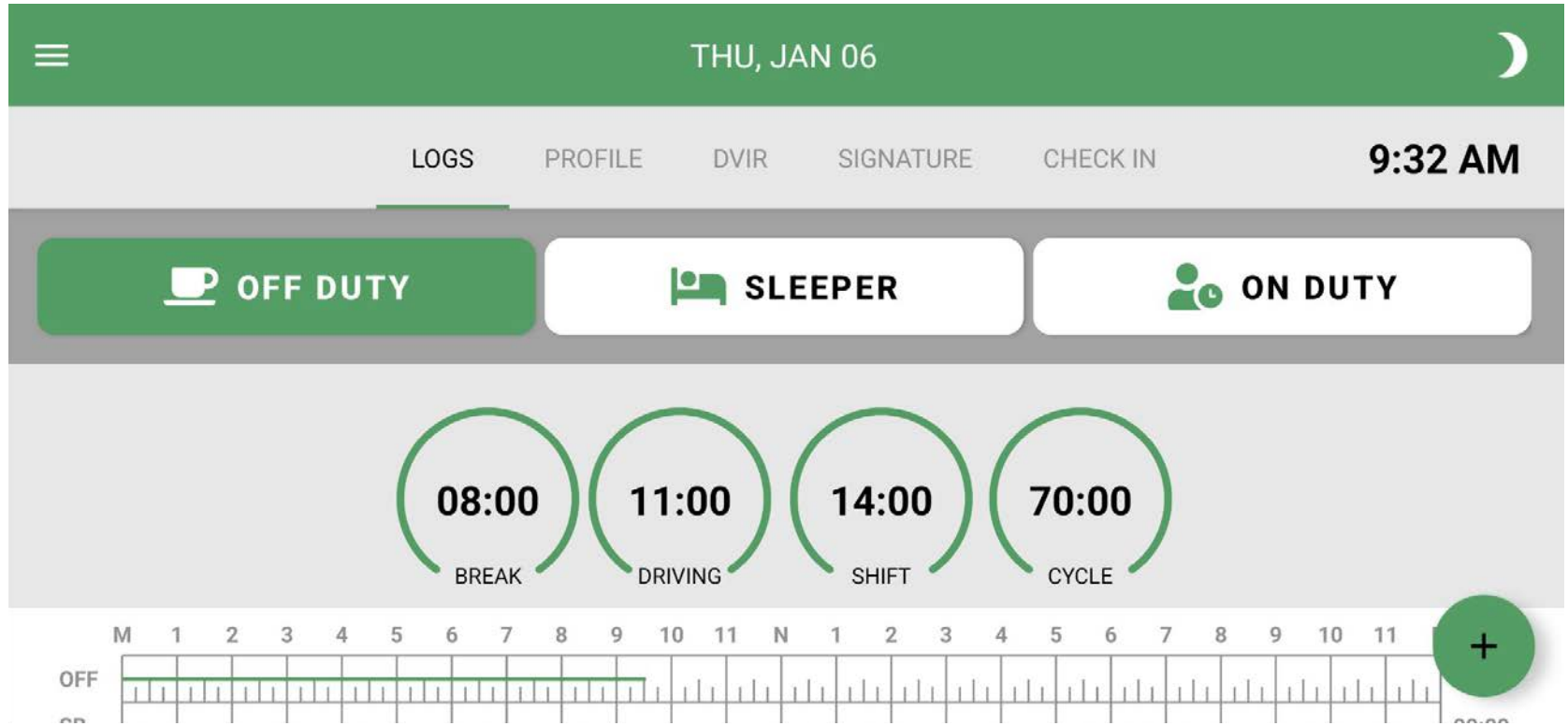
